- Write a one page summary of the story. Include the main characters and their role in the story, related themes and plot analysis.
- Write a one page critique (reaction) of the book. Give your opinion of the book. Give specific examples from the story to back up your opinions. Tell whether you would recommend the book for a friend.
- Design a creative cover page showcasing your talents. Include the title and author as well as your name and grade.

In addition, you are asked to design an artistic interpretation of one of these literary works. Some suggestions are:
